Ancient, wild, alive - the historic sites of Western Newfoundland and Labrador are all within a few hours travel of each other, feature two UNESCO World Heritage Sites, and offer experiences as diverse as the stories and landscapes they commemorate. Discover the Vikings, a 16th century Basque whaling station and the vibrant story of 6,000 years of Indigenous cultures.

FOSSILS, WHALES, CARIBOU

Available May-Oct

Take the 5-minute drive along the paved road from the Visitor Centre to Point Riche Lighthouse. Discover rare plants thriving on the limes tone barrens, take in the pictures que lighthouse, search the beach for fossils embedded in limes tone, scan the horizon for whales and potentially spot grazing caribou.
